Job Description:

The Potting Shop Manager will be a member of the Management Team, and directly report to the Director of Nursery Operations. This is a full time position from March 1st - December 24th. This role will manage the day-to-day activities of the potting shop, and focus on helping define and build processes around our already robust residential business with a new focus on building a best-in-class repeatable commercial program.

The Potting Shop Manager will be responsible for continuing and building on the wonderful reputation of Lang's Garden. The Potting Shop manager is a customer-facing and highly collaborative role, and will require excellent organizational and communication skills.

- Daily Capturing all charges incurred. Working with the Nursery Services manager to understand costs of delivery and placement
- Daily Ensure photos are captured and stored at all phases in the customer file on Google Drive; including the store services manager or delivery team is capturing location photos as well.
- Active learning of new design trends, understanding of what works best in our area, and developing and documenting repeatable best practices
- Manage people associated with the potting shop
